Brandenburg: Hat trick as Germany's greenest state

Brandenburg remains Germany's leading state for renewable energies like wind power and photovoltaics. On 13th December 2012, it was awarded the „Guiding Star“ state prize for the third time in succession from the Federal Renewable Energies Agency. Members of the agency include the Federal Ministries for Environment and for Consumer Protection as well as more than 100 companies and associations in the sector. 53 factors were used as a basis for classifications and, besides actual figures for growth, objectives and measures set by the state governments were also assessed. Brandenburg has no intention of resting on its laurels however. According to Ralf Christoffers, Economic Minister for the State of Brandenburg, challenges ahead include finding solutions for the storage capability of energy and pushing on with the extension of electricity supply networks.

Berlin: Fashion store Zalando creates 300 new jobs

The online fashion retailer Zalando plans to create 300 new jobs in Berlin in the coming year. The company, which already employs around 1,000 employees in Berlin and has become one of the most successful fashion retailers in Europe, is planning to move its headquarters in Prenzlauer Berg to a larger 20,000 m² building in Friedrichshain in April 2013. Besides shoes and fashion items, Zalando now offers sports shoes, sports clothing and sports accessories as well as outdoor clothing. The company, which was founded in 2008 and started its operation in Germany and Austria, is today also operationally active in France, Italy, the Netherlands, Switzerland, England, Spain, Belgium, Sweden, Denmark, Finland, Poland and Norway and is therefore the largest online retailer of shoes in Europe. Made in Germany: Conergy's PV modules defy even the worst storms
